Best weed control will result if applied before weeds sprout since the product acts as a pre-emergent and also a post-emergent weed killer. Established weeds are harder to kill and may require an additional application in the fall or spring. Apply January 1 and March 1 for the best control otherwise product may be applied up to June 15 with good weed Control.
