GENERAL INFORMATION: *CrossOver Turf* is a granular soil product for turfgrasses with calcium and magnesium deficiencies. It will also aid turfgrass soils with chemical imbalances, structural instability and ion toxicity issues associated with low pH, salt-affected and high pH sodic soils. Turfgrass species may also benefit from supplemental levels of monosilicic acid that help improve crop tolerance to abiotic stresses such as cold, heat and drought, as well as improve plant structural strength.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Proper application rates and frequency should be determined by specific conditions and plant requirements. A soil analysis is recommended prior to application of *CrossOver Turf*. Apply *CrossOver Turf* during periods of high calcium demand such as cell division and initiation of root growth. Apply at 5-10 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. per month during a 3-month treatment period to build sufficient calcium and silicon reserves in the soil. *CrossOver Turf* can also be applied as a single treatment at 25-30 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft.
